

# Make-up List

**Lindon and Orem Wal-Marts** are good places to find make-up items. Approximate prices below are from the Orem Wal-Mart. You can also find things at Target, Shopko, and Kmart. **Grocery stores** may be better for hair supplies and some make-up. Use **Taylor Maid** in Provo as a last resort because they are more expensive, however they do have specialty items such as hair buns.

## Make-up

- Black Mascara
  - Cheapest ones I found: Wet N Wild \$1.97 or NYC \$1.72
- Black Eye liner (Pencil is best)
  - Cheapest ones: NYC 93¢, Wet N Wild 93¢
  - Or NYC twin pack you could split with someone else for \$1.72
- Eye Shadow
  - **Revlon 325 “Blushed Wines”** \$4.97 (4 shades) ←This is the set of colors you should get.
  - If you can't find the Revlon, please try more than one store first.
  - If you still can't find it call me for another option.
- Blush
  - **Wet N Wild “Heather Silk”** - for \$2.97 ←This is the color you should get.
  - If you can't find it then one of the following
    - NYC Riverside Rose \$2.72
    - Covergirl Rock N Rose \$3.74
- Powder – 3 or 4 shades darker than natural skin color
  - NYC Pressed Powder Bronzer \$2.88 - 720A “Sunny”
    - probably a good color for most of you
  - Rimmel Pressed Powder/Bronzer \$3.87
- Black Eyelashes & Eyelash Glue
  - Eyelashes should be long and somewhat thick.
  - Package may say “ready to wear” w/o glue – **you will still need glue.**
  - NYC Eyelashes 974A or 972B \$2.72
  - Salon Perfect has Sizes: 45, 53, 28, or Demi Wispies - probably not 13, 21, 33, 110
  - Salon Perfect Glue and Eyelashes separately \$2.98 each
  - Salon Perfect has a combo pack of eyelashes & glue for \$4.98
- Foundation - 3 to 4 shades darker than your natural skin color
  - A cream, mousse, or liquid-to-powder are usually better because they are thicker than liquid.
  - Foam wedges - best when applying cream or liquid foundations.
    - **The wedges are optional**
    - Bag of wedges for \$1.75. (You may want to get together and split the wedges and cost.)
    - NYC – 3 wedges for \$1.72.
- Lipstick -
  - Wet N Wild color #508 93¢
  - If you can't find this one then try one of the following:
    - Wet N Wild #541 93¢
    - NYC #320 \$1.24
- Box/bag
  - To put all hair and make-up supplies in; things are easy to lose if they are only in a plastic grocery bag.
  - The size you will need can find these at Walmart in the \$8-\$12, please get one large enough to fit all make-up and most hair items. (may exclude hairspray/gel bottles)

## Hair

- Comb
  - Prefer a Rat-tail comb. Best for parting your hair.
- Hair Gel
  - Can be any brand
- Hair Spray
  - Can be any brand – extra hold is best, preferably not spray gel

- Hair Elastics
  - Elastics should be a color that blends into your hair or black/brown
  - If you have long hair you will need at least 4-5 elastics
- Bobby pins
  - Regular size, not the huge ones.
  - Also should blend into your hair color
  - Brown is usually good for any hair color
  - If you have a lot of hair you may need large and regular size pins
- Hair Net
  - Close to the same color as your hair
  - This one does matter more that you get a color that is close to your own
- Fake Hair Bun - *only if your hair is too short to do a bun.*
  - Michelle has one Platinum Blonde bun.
  - You can purchase these at Taylor Maid in Provo.
  - Must be in the shape of a bun. (Not curls in a hair net.)

## Tanning

- Tanning Lotion
  - Tanning of some sort will be required for competitions, concerts, and various shows.
  - We recommend Sunless Tanning lotion. Brands such as St. Tropez or Neutrogena.
  - St. Tropez is found at Taylor Maid – it is most natural looking but is more expensive.
  - Other Brands can be found at Wal-Mart.
  - The color depends on the brand – but you will want one that says something like “Extra Deep” or “Dark.”
  - Lotions will require 3 applications. Meaning you will need to start using it 3-4 days before a performance.
  - Other options would be Tanning Mist at tanning salons. This option is usually \$15 or more per mist. However each performance should only take one mist.
  - We do not recommend any sort of UV tanning.
  - DO NOT use a tanning option that will wash off the next day. When you sweat it gets all over the costumes.

## Optional Items (but highly recommended)

In order of importance:

- Facial Cleansing Towels – *Super Highly Recommended* (of all optional things, I would say get this one!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!)
- Equate Facial Cleansing Towelletes \$4.67/box
- Makes taking make-up off so much easier and faster!!!!
- Once you try these you’ll never go back... I sound like a commercial... but trust me!
- Big Brush – *Also Super Highly Recommended*
  - Best for blush and bronzer. Makes it much easier to put on.
- Hair pins
  - Close to your hair color.
  - I recommend these, they really help to hold the bun without messing up the shape of your bun.
- Green Cover Stick – extra cover for those unsightly red blemishes we all experience: NYC \$1.72
- Lip Liner – a color that matches lipstick

## Clothing:

- Fishnets
  - **Caramel or Toffee color**
  - Medium/Tall will probably fit most of you. Buy them a little big, so they won’t squeeze the life out of you. ☺ Medium/Tall fits me comfortably.
- Leotard
  - **Nude color**, fitted, with bra support.
    - All straps should be worn over the shoulder – not criss cross. Especially clear straps.
  - **Bras are not worn during performances. Bra straps will show depending on the costume.**
- Bra Cups - stitch them in your leotard. Best kind is found at JoAnn’s fabric.
